- For Catholic patients, visitors, staff, and volunteers, the Sacraments of Reconciliation, Anointing of the Sick, and Eucharist are available. The Liturgy of the Eucharist will be celebrated on Thursdays and Fridays at 11:30 a.m. and on Sundays at 1:30 p.m.
