Our chaplains are here to help you in your journey. We respond to your needs by:

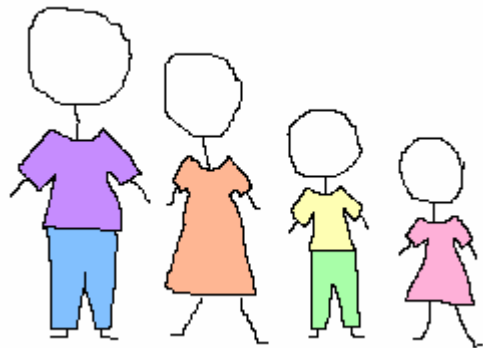
- Listening to your story

How To Contact Us

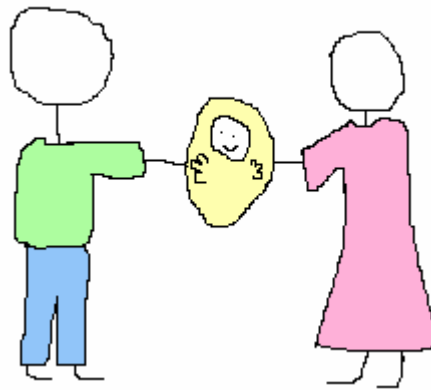
- A chaplain is available 24 hours a day.

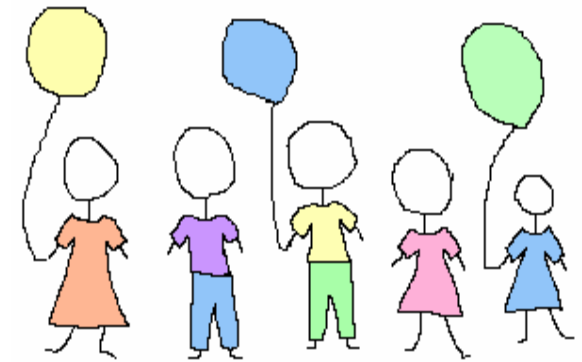

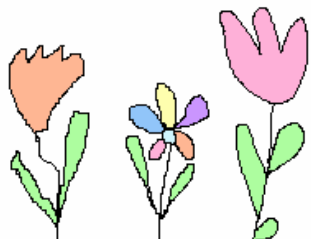
Our Mission at SSM Cardinal Glennon Children's Hospital

Pastoral Care Department:

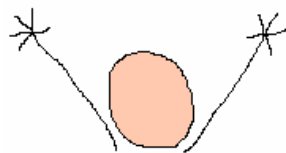
The Pastoral Care Department ministers to the children, their parents, family and friends, as well as the staff who cares for the children.

Communication—How do I speak what is in my heart?

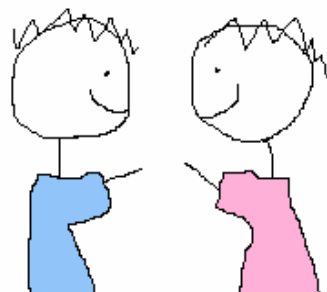
Forgiveness—Am I holding resentments inside?

Trust—What helps me most when I feel afraid?

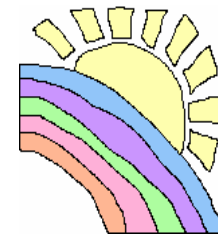
Values—What do I believe in that guides how I act?
