- Chaplains maintain confidentiality and provide a supportive context in which patients can discuss their concerns
- Coverage is provided by the spiritual care department 24 hours a day

Spiritual Care is primarily a ministry of compassionate presence realized, at St. James Healthcare, through the following services:

- Assistance in preparing Advanced Directives for Healthcare
- Bereavement/grief support
- Crisis support
- Ethical consultation about treatment and end-of-life issues
- Prayer, rituals and sacraments
- Pre/Post surgery support
- Regular patient/family visits
- Seasonal prayer services
- Sensitivity to a variety of cultural traditions
- Spiritual assessment as part of a treatment team

TV Channel 3 provides spiritual programming with soothing imagery, music and spiritual inspiration.

A Chaplain may be called when...

- ☞ you feel confused or upset
- ☞ you are asking "Why?"
- ☞ your family is upset
- ☞ you wish to receive a sacrament
- ☞ you want someone to pray with you before/after surgery
- ☞ you've received a difficult diagnosis
- ☞ you want to contact your pastor/minister
- ☞ you have difficult decisions to make
- ☞ someone close to you is dying
- ☞ you are grieving
- ☞ you want strength, courage, and hope beyond your own
