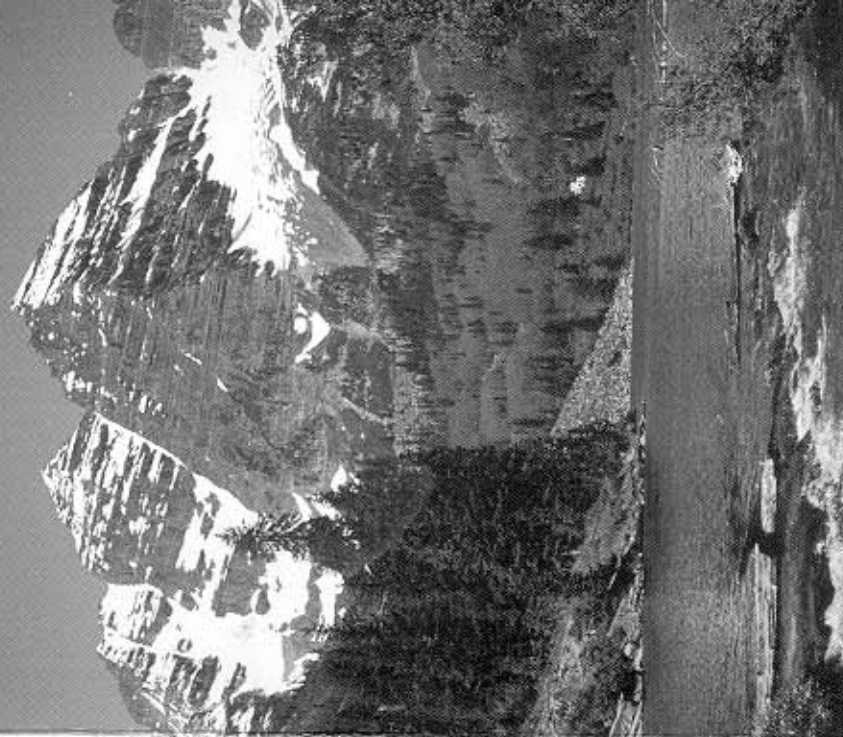

### Penrose-St. Francis Health Services Colorado Springs, CO

Faith-based health care in Colorado Springs began in 1887 when the Sisters of St. Francis began a ministry to injured miners. Three years later the Sisters began their ministry to tuberculosis patients. Today, the hospital has evolved into a multisite facility with specialties in cardiovascular services, cancer diagnosis and treatment, orthopedic specialties, labor and delivery, and a host of medical and surgical services covering the range of modern health care. The hospital has a Level II trauma designation with the latest in technological critical care services.

The Department of Mission and Ministry is host to the CPE program, spiritual care and community outreach ministries with a staff of pastoral nurses.
